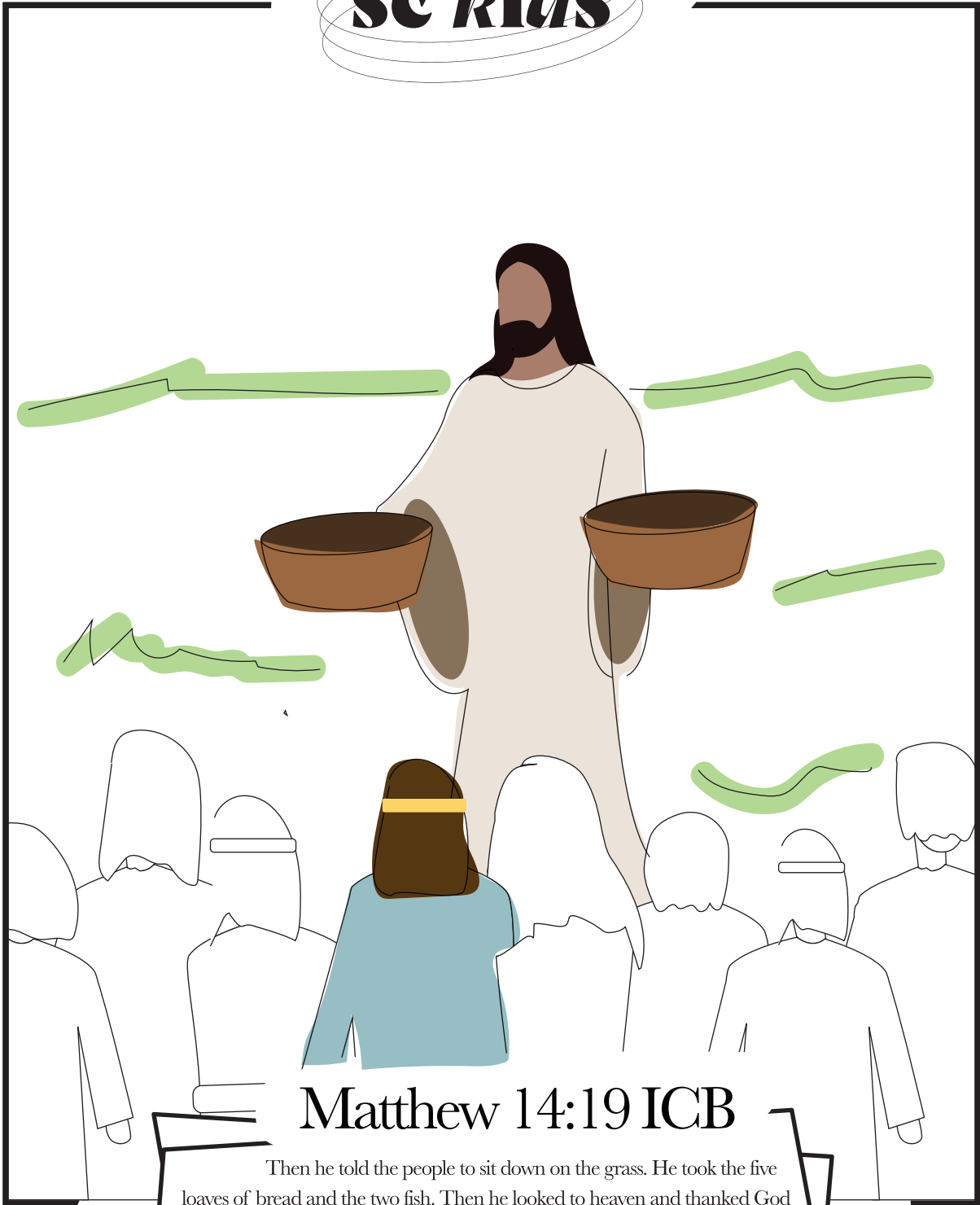
Once, Jesus encountered a vast, hungry crowd late in the day. His disciples worried about the lack of food nearby and suggested sending the people away.
